

Course Description:

PARCOR offers a comprehensive range of Emergency Response Team (ERT) Training Programs. There are three different streams which an organisation can obtain the very best ERT Training and Team Development skills.

Course Streams:

Certificate II in Public Safety (Firefighting and Emergency Operations)

Certificate III in Public Safety (Firefighting and Emergency Operations)

Units of Competency - a full range of ERT related Training Units (see back page for Units offered)

Note - Certificates II and III require full enrolment into each level.

Delivery Method:

The delivery method is either On Site training at your Organisation's premises or at one of our Training Centres.

On Site Training can be conducted if access to a range of emergency equipment appropriate to the site's emergency requirements and a suitable training room is available for use.

Group Size:

To ensure quality training and a safe learning environment, the maximum allowable group size is 12 participants.

What information will PARCOR require?

Due to training requirements, PARCOR will need to be provided with the following information prior to training commencement;

- Copy of Site's Emergency Management Plan
- Copy of chemical manifest on-site
- Copy of current Emergency Equipment Register
- Copy of a previous ERT training records or qualifications (if applicable)

What will your organisation receive?

- Statement of Attainment for individual participants
- Training Report for your Health and Safety Office Compliance File
