



Course Description:

This is a course designed to provide the skills and knowledge for those who are required to deal with Hot Work Permits. Include option for blanket hot work permits and other permits that may be applicable in conjunction with hot work permits.

Course Content:

- WHS/OHS Introduction
- Safe Work Permits
- Hot Work Permits
- Hot Works Supervision
- Hot Works Inspection on site
- Hot Works location
- Hot Works – Fire Watching
- Practical exercises using fire extinguishers

Delivery Method:

Face to Face training will be conducted over a period of 2 hours.

Training can be conducted both on or offsite provided access to a range of emergency equipment appropriate to the sites emergency plan and a suitable training room is available for use.

Group Size:

To ensure quality training and a safe learning environment, the maximum allowable group size is 12 participants.

What information will PARCOR require?
